

Pronoun Cases

Pronoun – takes the place of a noun

Case – **how** and **where** the pronoun is used in a sentence

<u>Number and Gender</u>	<u>Subject</u>	<u>Object</u> (receives verb)	<u>Possessive</u> (ownership)	<u>Reflexive</u> (emphasis)
1 st person singular	I	me	my, mine	myself
1 st person plural	We	us	our, ours	ourselves
2 nd person singular	You	you	your, yours	yourself
3 rd person singular male	He	him	his	himself, his self
3 rd person singular female	She	her	her, hers	herself
3 rd person singular unknown	It	it	its (No apostrophe!)	itself
3 rd person plural	They	them	their, theirs	themselves, their selves
